A cloze test is a type of exercise, test, or evaluation where a participant is required to fill in a segment of text that has been masked. To correctly identify the language or part of speech that belongs in the deleted paragraphs, cloze exams demand an understanding of the vocabulary and context. This task is frequently used to evaluate instruction and learning of both native and second languages.

One extremely unique type of insect is the honey bee. Unlike other solitary insects, honey bees are a member of a community. A bee colony is where these bees reside together. The queen bee is the leader of the colony. Laying eggs is her primary responsibility to the colony. The worker bees feed on pollen and nectar from flowers. After being transported by the worker bees, the nectar is placed on the hive and transformed into honey.
