Examples: Dog, City, Happiness Types: Common, Proper, Abstract, Concrete, Collective **Pronouns** 

Words that replace nouns.

Examples: He, She, It, They, Who

Types: Personal, Reflexive, Relative, Demonstrative

Verbs

Words that express actions or states of being.

Examples: Run, Jump, Is, Was

Types: Action, Linking, Helping

Adjectives

Words that describe or modify nouns.

Examples: Beautiful, Large, Quick

Questions They Answer: What kind? How many? Which one?

Adverbs

Words that describe verbs, adjectives, or other adverbs.

Examples: Quickly, Very, Extremely

Questions They Answer: How? When? Where? To what extent?

Prepositions
Words that show relationships between nouns/pronouns and other words in a sentence.
Examples: In, On, At, By
Conjunctions
Words that connect words, phrases, or clauses.
Examples: And, But, Or
Types: Coordinating, Subordinating, Correlative
Interjections

Words or phrases that express strong emotion.

Examples: Wow! Ouch! Hurray!
