

## 2.5 NUMERICAL ADJECTIVE

Numerical Adjectives indicate how many persons or things are meant or in what order a person or thing stands

*Note: Numbers should be written in words till the numbers “10” and plurals should not be used in answers.*

### Examples:

- 1) A bottle with a capacity of 10 litres – A ten litre capacity bottle
- 2) A pipe of 3 feet length – A three-foot pipe
- 3) A lamp power of 60 watts – A sixty-watt lamp
- 4) An investment of 5 lakhs – A five lakh investment
- 5) A journey of 200 miles – A two-hundred-mile journey
- 6) An interval of 15 minutes – A 15-minute interval
- 7) A tank capacity of 2000 liters – A 2000-liter capacity tank

### Exercise:

- 1) A journey of 50 miles
- 2) A lecture for 3 hours
- 3) An expedition lasting for 5 days
- 4) A research grant of Rs 2 lakhs
- 5) A stamp with a value of Rs 5
- 6) A cricket match lasting five days
- 7) A drive for 8 hours
- 8) A tank with a capacity of 1000 gallons
- 9) A road measuring 100 feet
- 10) A walk of 5 miles
