## ANNUAL REPORT – 2023-24

I am very happy to place before you a brief report of the college for the academic year 2023-24.

Rohini college of Engineering & Technology (RCET), is a self-finance Engineering College started in 2012 under the auspices of Saroja Trust, a charitable educational trust of Rohini Group. First, I extend a warm welcome and my sincere gratitude to our Chairman Dr.K.Neela Marthandan. It is his great vision, single-minded devotion, unshakable determination, child-like enthusiasm, hard work, secular outlook and humane approach that have made RCET what it is today. Under the able guidance and adept administration of Dr.N.Neela Vishnu, Pro-Chairman & Dr.V.M.Blessy Geo, the Managing Director of the college has developed excellent facilities and resources such as spacious classrooms, seminar halls, well equipped laboratories, excellent sporting facilities, dedicated high speed internet connectivity (broadband) and well-qualified faculty. Five Academic Blocks house different departments. Our institution is accredited with **A+ Grade** by **the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC)** in April 2023 and **AUTONOMOUS status** in March 2024. I extend my sincere gratitude to our Pro-Chairman and Managing Director for their dedicated service towards the growth of RCET.

Our current academic year started on 1<sup>st</sup> July 2023 and will go on till June 30<sup>th</sup> 2024.

We offer **8 UG programmes** in engineering namely, Mechanical Engineering, Civil Engineering, Electrical and Electronics Engineering, Electronics and Communication Engineering and Computer Science and Engineering, Biomedical Engineering, Agricultural Engineering, AI and Data Science, **4 PG programmes** namely, M.E-Computer Science and engineering, M.E-Communication Systems, M.E-Construction Engineering and Management and M.E-Thermal Engineering and **Ph.D in Mechanical Engineering**. The Institute is an ISO 9001:2015 certified. The college is affiliated to Anna University Chennai.

- Introduced B.Tech-Artificial Intelligence and Data Science with an intake of 60, MCA with an intake of 60 and increased the intake of MBA to 120 students.
- All the first year seats got filled in 2023-2024 admissions. I am very happy to share that our college stood number one in our district in terms of the number of students admitted for the last eight years.
- The Institute has 2001 BE students, 246 B.Tech students, 98 ME students, 186 MBA students, 55 MCA students and 10 Ph.D students.
- 187 boys and 97 girls students stay in the college Hostels. The college has about 34 buses for daily commuters.

- 83 students are from other states like Kerala, Manipur.
- The quality of the faculty and the student/faculty ratio are the key determinants of the standard of education. RCET is endowed with 137 highly qualified, experienced and devoted faculty members. Of these, 39 are doctoral degree holders. 119 non-teaching staff are working here. As on date, the student/faculty ratio of the college is 1:15 by admitted students.
